I hope you are all keeping well and are fully recovered from all the December and January festivities. Many of you will have been on your annual holidays and are now back at work. Kids and older students have started, or are about to start, a new year at school or uni.

In Community Theatre we're at that time when most theatres are re-opening with their first offerings of the new year. Rehearsals are at the pointy end, and everybody is scrambling to fit it all in. There are just not enough hours in the day.

As I write this, the three comedies in the Comedy Carousel - All I Really Need to Know I Learned by being in a Bad Murder Mystery, Therapy Go Round and The Heist are in final rehearsals, and if you haven't booked your tickets, you'd better do so now, as seats are selling fast. How lucky are we to have playwrights Sean Guy and Shirley Toohey attend the performances on Saturday 8th, and hold an short Q & A session after Curtain Down.

Auditions for Season Two Sweeney Todd, the Demon Barber of Fleet Street, directed by Rebekah Hannah are being held on 22nd February. Performance dates 5th to 21st June.

Our In-House Awards Night is coming up on Saturday 22nd February, and as usual I am calling for Nominations from 2024 for the Golden Gazzunder. You know the drill. Please, please contact me asap, dobbing in someone, or several someones, who made a big blooper, or bloopers, during a show. It could be on stage, backstage, Front of House, during rehearsal. Nobody is safe or exempt. I am willing to keep your identity a secret, for a price.

On a more sombre note, sadly the outside world occasionally invades our make-believe space. We have had 3 unrelated cases of Covid made known to us. Therefore, I beg you all not to be complacent, but to use your common sense and take all precautions, not just with Covid but all infectious illnesses, to prevent them spreading. Masks and hand sanitiser are available for use at the theatre, for your own protection, but please stay away if you are sick, and notify to your director or stage manager. Scheduling and Availability - Coordinating everyone's schedules is a challenge. Our cast and crew juggle jobs, families, and other commitments, making it a puzzle to find common rehearsal times. Flexibility and teamwork are key.

The Creative Process - In rehearsals, we delve into the characters, exploring their motivations and the play's deeper meanings. This journey is both exciting and demanding.

Long Hours and Hard Work - Rehearsals often stretch late into the night. Our dedication shines through as we work tirelessly to perfect our performances. It's our shared passion for theatre that keeps us going.

Sourcing Props and Set Pieces - Creating our play's world involves sourcing props and furniture, often on a tight budget. We rely on our prop pieces, sleuth marketplaces and create DIY solutions, carefully selecting each piece to enhance our storytelling.

Publicity and Meetings - Promoting our play is crucial. We design posters, manage social media, and reach out to local media to ensure a good turnout. Regular meetings keep us all on the same page.


Technical Aspects - Setting and plotting lights and sound cues require precision. Our technicians Don and Geoff work closely with our directors to create the desired atmosphere and ensure smooth transitions during the show.

Memorising Lines and Sorting Costumes - Actors spend countless hours memorising lines and blocking. Meanwhile, our actors and creative teams coordinate costumes, ensuring each piece reflects the character and period of the play.

Bringing a show to life at Garrick Theatre is a complex and rewarding endeavour. Despite the challenges, the joy of creating and sharing a theatrical experience with our community makes it all worthwhile.


